



SOP Tulco Revision B, 08/21/2019 Approved by: Stuart Lough

PURPOSE: Add deacom Part Number & Barcode to Tulco-wercs Labels.

PROCESS STEPS:

- 1. From the Wercs Login
- 2. Distribution > Label Designer (this opens a desktop app at Tom's PC)
- 3. Open Project...choose Label to be edited
- 4. Choose Project > Project Options > Template Fields tab (to add the PART# data field to the label)




5. Click New[page icon] > type "PART#" in both fileds (leave Type = Text)



- 6. Press Ok to save "Template Field"
- 7. Press Ok to save "Label Project Options"
- 8. Add Barcode to document (test size was Width: 2.68, Height: 0.77)
- 9. Change Barcode Type to "EAN128", Text to DynamicText and (90){p|PART#}(10){p|BATCHNO}

Note: vertical bar, the pipe is a computer keyboard key "|" that is two vertical lines above one another and commonly looks like a full vertical line. This symbol is found on the same United States QWERTY keyboard key as the backslash key.








